4	Hours of Services	a) Operating hours: 8.00am-5.30pm
		b) Duration of therapy session: Up to 1 hour/ session
5	Days of Services	a) Monday - Friday
6	Frequency of Services	a) Frequency and type of services (PT, OT &/or ST) depends upon assessment and recommendation from the therapists.
		 b) Clients in Active rehab program will receive up to five sessions per week, depending on the assessment by the AHP professionals.

7	Payer sources	a) Eligible clients will be offered subsidies according to government schemes.

11	Intake Criteria	a)	Adult (18 years of age and above)
		b)	Stable medical or post- surgical condition that requires active rehabilitation. Clients with unstable medical conditions that require close medical monitoring will not be accepted.
		c)	Stable behaviourial or psychological status that requires active rehabilitation. Clients with unmanageable behavioural issues and/or uncontrolled mental illness despite treatment that causes harm to the person, others, or be disruptive will not be accepted.
		d)	Free from any active contagious infectious diseases (e.g., chicken pox, scabies). An additional medical clearance from a doctor may be required to certify client as safe for community rehabilitation. Client with untreated infectious diseases that require isolation will not be accepted.
		e)	Participation restriction: Clients with restrictions that ranges from active in life role to total dependency will be accepted where active therapy goals to be identified and agreed between therapists and the client and/or caregivers. Clients whose case needs cannot be adequately and safely provided for in the centre will not be accepted.
		f)	Medical Stability: Clients with stable vital signs; and can be receiving other treatments such as dialysis, acupuncture etc.

		c)	[For Community Rehabilitation only] Certified by a Singapore Medical Council registered medical practitioner, Singapore Nursing Board registed Advanced Practice Nurse, or Allied Health Professional Council full-registered therapist that continuous rehabilitation will NOT lead to further significant functional improvement.			
		d)	Refusal or unable to comply with the prescribed programme.			
		e)	Behaviour that endangers the safety of themselves, other clients, staff or volunteers			
		f)	For poor attendance, if client is absent for more than 50% of scheduled sessions in a month without valid reason, discharge will be proposed.			
		g)	Hospitalization/Institutional care for over 1 month			
		h)	Absent or uncontactable for more than 1 month without valid reason			
		i)	Client, caregiver or family members who disregard our Centre's policies, rules and regulations.
